Every culture has one worth listening to.



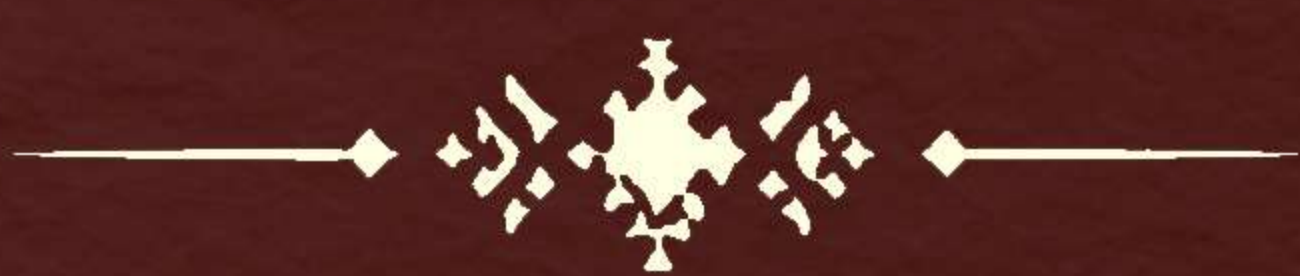
This day was more than a celebration.

Indigenous communities.

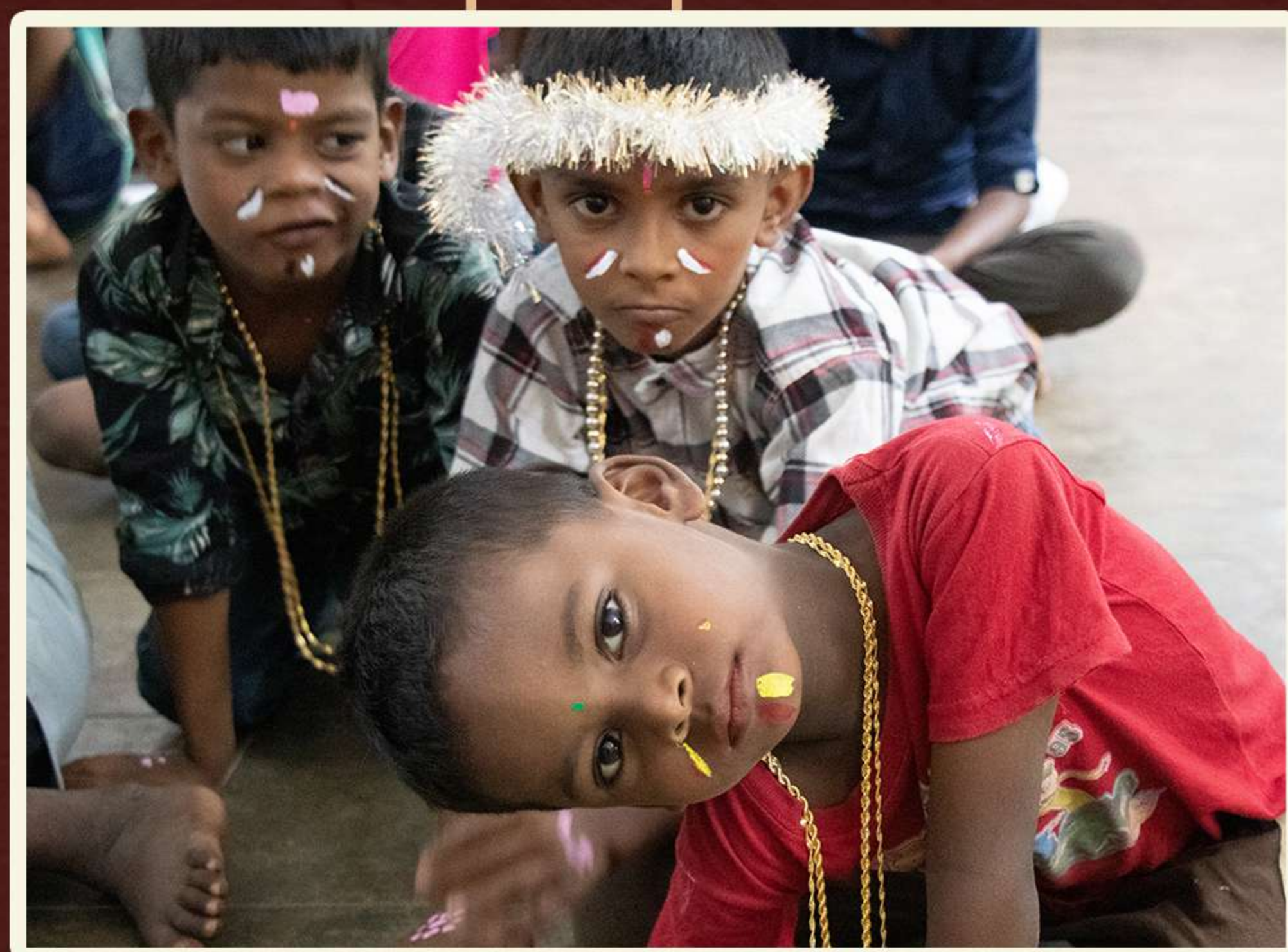


Sometimes,
